# The Tourist Office is committed to

## a CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) policy

ONLYLYON Tourism and Convention's CSR policy is related to the missions and values of the organisation, which is committed to respecting the four fundamental principles of sustainable development – a duty of care, of inclusion, of integrity and of transparency – as well as to taking into account the principle of universal accessibility.

Bring on board our 80 employees as we improve our impacts, and be exemplary to show the way and potential areas for action to our entire ecosystem.

- → Analysis of our carbon footprint in 2019, 2020 and 2022, with an action plan for the reduction and improvement of our environmental impacts.
- → International event sustainability certification (ISO 20121) for our action towards responsible event planning and the promotion of an engaged destination since March 2022.
- → The CSR Commitment Label from AFNOR related to the ISO 26000 standard, achieved in March 2023 and implemented by Collectif EcoRSE, a collective formed of a dozen of the organisation's employees, which works to continuously improve our practices.
- → Coordination of the operational strategy, with a multi-year action plan from 2021 to 2026.

# The Tourist Office's actions

#### to assist its members

Assist all of the socio-professional actors that are members and tourism stakeholders in the Lyon metropolitan area, to pursue the ecological transition and meet the sustainable development goals of our sector.

Raise-awareness and train professionals on environmental and social challenges:

- → Fresque du Climat (Climate Fresk), Fresque de l'Evénementiel Responsible (an overview of responsible event planning), initiating a CSR approach, sustainable forms of mobility in the local area, the circular economy and waste recovery, biodiversity in urban areas....
- → Several specific ONLYLYON events related to sustainable tourism proposed each year for our members.

Involve local residents in considerations and the Sustainable Tourism Strategy: online consultation, organisation of meetings and workshops to compare the views of residents and tourism professionals in LyonTourisme Responsable.

Support the transformation of practices through technical and financial assistance:

- \_ help to achieve environmental certification of tourism activities (accommodation, restaurants, leisure);
- assistance in transitioning to responsible event planning;
- assistance with sustainable food;
- assistance with accessibility, carbon footprint assessment, etc.;
- \_ several support programmes offered to members each year.

Deploy and promote inclusive and sustainable approaches: Accueil vélo, Lyon ville équitable et durable, Tourisme & Handicap, Gourdefriendly.

Communicate about Lyon as destination transitioning towards responsible tourism.

- → A Green Committee within the board of ONLYLYON Tourism and Conventions to approve strategies, actions plans for coming years and measure their impacts on a regular basis.
